



Gas Network Upgrade – Lunsford Lane, Aylesford.

We're preparing to carry out essential gas network upgrades in the Lunsford Lane area of Aylesford. This work will ensure a continued safe and reliable supply of gas is delivered to nearby homes and businesses. This is part of our 30-year programme of work to replace our old mains, reaching the end of their useful lives, with new, reliable plastic pipe.

Our contractor, WCB Utilities, who are completing this project on our behalf, will be starting work in the week beginning 20 January. We expect this project to last for approximately 14 weeks.

To ensure everyone's safety, we'll need to close some of the roads around our work site while we have excavations open.

Gighill Road – will be closed from 20 January for approximately three weeks. We'll be working from the junction with Lunsford Lane to the junction with Chaucer Lane. We'll also be using two-way traffic lights on Lunsford Lane near the junction with Gighill Road.

A228 Castle Way & Malling Road – Lane closures will be in place from 3 February for approximately four weeks. We'll be working from outside 155 Castle Way to the roundabout at the junction with Hays Road.

Lunsford Lane (Phase 1) - Leybourne Way to Malling Road – will be closed from 10 February for approximately seven weeks. This will be a rolling closure that will move along the road with the work. While the road is closed from Leybourne Way to Leybourne Lakes, the existing one-way system will be reversed and access for the lakes will be via the Malling Road lay by. Informational signage will be in place on Malling Road and Leybourne Way to advise when this is in force.

Springfield Road - will be closed from 17 March for approximately four weeks

Lunsford Lane (Phase 2) - Brook Road to M20 Bridge – will be closed from 7 April for approximately nine weeks

Signed diversions will be in place for affected motorists where roads are closed. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses.

We understand roadworks can be frustrating. However, the new plastic pipe has a lifespan of 80 years. This means that once our work is done, Aylesford residents and businesses will be able to enjoy the benefits of a safe and reliable supply of gas for many years to come.
