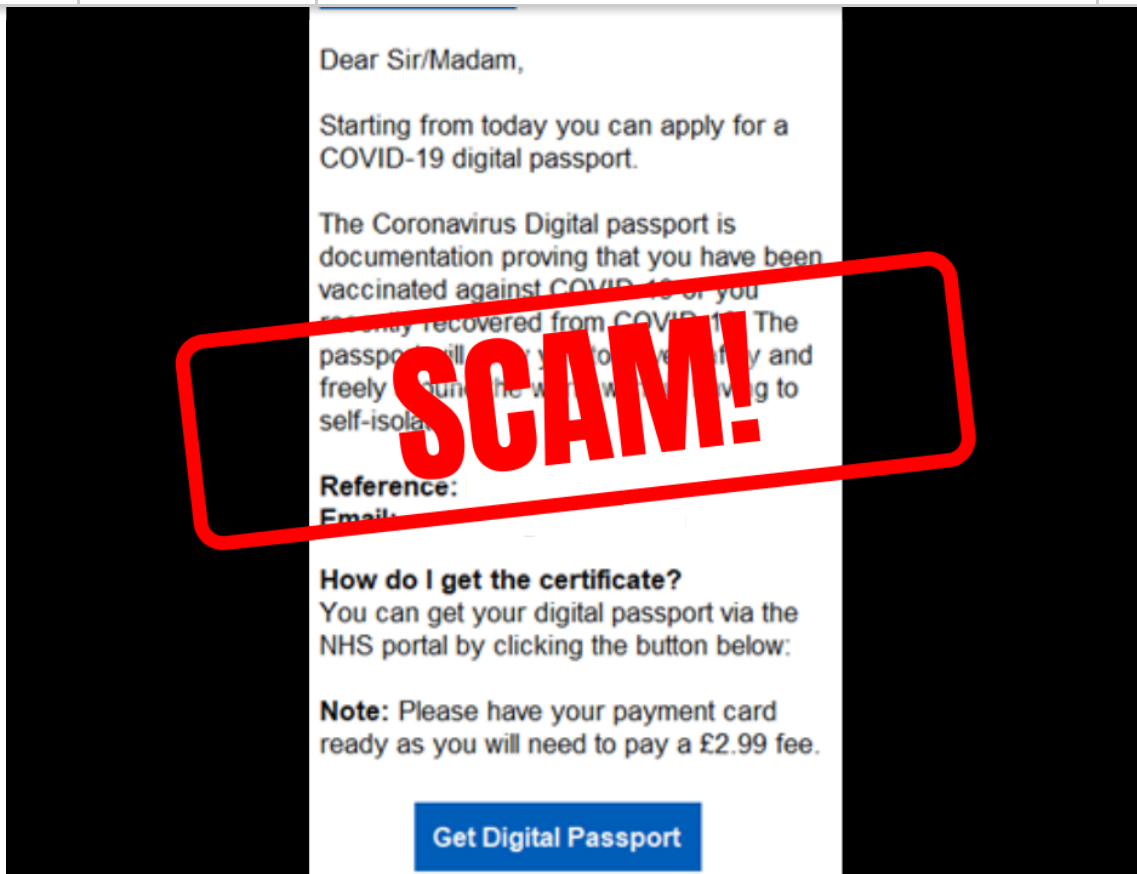


## Criminals target Kent residents with Covid Pass scam

We have received reports of Kent residents being targeted by Covid Pass scam.

### What happens:

- Scammers will target via emails, texts and social media.
- You are asked to click a link.
- You may be asked for a payment details or personal information.

- Do not respond - this is a **SCAM**
- The NHS will never ask for a payment or financial details.
- Forward scam texts to 7726 and then delete the message.
