A20 London Road, Aylesford
(PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN & BUS LANE CLOSURE)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow works to be carried out to install a rising main, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A20 London Road, Aylesford.

The restrictions are planned from 24th July 2023, with estimated completion by 1st September 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27877479467 - Walker Construction Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A westbound bus lane closure will be in place on A20 London Road near the junction with London Road East for 275 metres west, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

It will be necessary to temporarily suspend the right turn Order on Culpeper Road, prohibiting traffic from turning right into the Royal British Legion Village.

The restrictions will be required for the safety of the public and workforce while works to install a rising main are undertaken by Walker Construction Ltd.
