The County Councillor member grant may also not be applicable for Highway Schemes.</p> <p>The process for obtaining 20mph speed restrictions can be broken down into the following steps -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.) ATC – week long automated speed surveys on the roads in question 2.) Review of the survey data and discussion about funding options 3.) Informal consultation to be carried out by the scheme promoters 4.) Funds identified for formal consultation and writing of TRO 5.) Respond to objectors and report to JTB 6.) Detailed scheme produced and funds identified for installation of speed limit change. <p>Suggestions for the following areas were put forward –</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Holmesdale School, Malling Road 2. St Katherines Lane 3. Roberts Road 4. Paddlesworth Road to Constitution Hill to Bull Corner 5. Rocfort Road to Queens Avenue <p>A discussion also took place regarding the difficulty in having multiple speeds along the Malling Road and therefore 20mph along the entire stretch of Malling Road/Holborough Road would be more appropriate. As requested by KCC Highways, areas should be added to the Highways improvement plan for a speed assessment to be carried out.</p> <p>RESOLVED to add the following areas to the Highway Improvement plan to enable automatic speed surveys to be carried out-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Holmesdale School, Malling Road 2. St Katherines Lane 3. Roberts Road 4. Paddlesworth Road to Constitution Hill to Bull Corner 5. Rocfort Road to Queens Avenue
