

'Migrant Helpline' scam email steals bank details

Criminals are using a genuine charity 'Migrant Helpline' to send scam emails that contain banking malware. If you click on the link in the email a well-known Trojan (Ramnit) will be downloaded to your device.

Once activated the malware targets and steals personal and business banking information.

If you receive this email delete it immediately

- · Don't click on links or open any attachments
- Check your antivirus software is running and up to date
- Contact your bank immediately if you think your bank details have been taken
